The Coroner system in South Carolina is antiquated and provides sub-optimal care.

It is an established fact that a Medical Examiner system with Forensic Pathologists performing the duties of death investigation and death certification is superior to lay coroners

Enact legislation to replace the Coroner system with a Medical Examiner system similar to the one in Florida. See Florida Statute 406.

Why is the Requested Action important?*

The current system does not provide a robust system for determining the cause of death.

In Florida the state is divided into districts and each district gets a medical examiner appointed by the governor to a three year term. The District Medical Examiner must be

a board certified Forensic Pathologist with a medical license. The system is more efficient because the medical examiner can perform autopsies as well as scene investigations and has more comprehensive training and knowledge for determining the cause of death.
